OUR WORK: SOME EXAMPLES

Advising on a joint venture between John Laing and Interserve on a £690m PFI project to create and manage flagship offices and a state of the art communications centre for 2,2000 military and civilian staff at Corsham, Wiltshire.

We advised Bristol Water on their Southern Resilience Scheme, an infrastructure project to improve security of water supply to over 280,000 customers south of Bristol. This included issues concerning Shute Shelve Tunnel, where there is a cycleway in a former railway tunnel in the ownership of North Somerset Council through which the new pipeline is former being laid.

We are advising on a number of hospital expansion schemes, including for Guy's and St Thomas NHS FT at the Evelina London Children's Hospital which involves a variety of preparatory projects. We acted for a Northern Russell Group University on a multimillion refurbishment of part of its city centre complex We advised on the form of the building contract and ancillary construction documents and on the negotiation with the major contractor.

A full indemnity was secured for the first incident from one of the sub-contractors and we also secured a dismissal at trial for the 2nd incident with the court determining that no such accident occurred. All defence costs were recovered.
